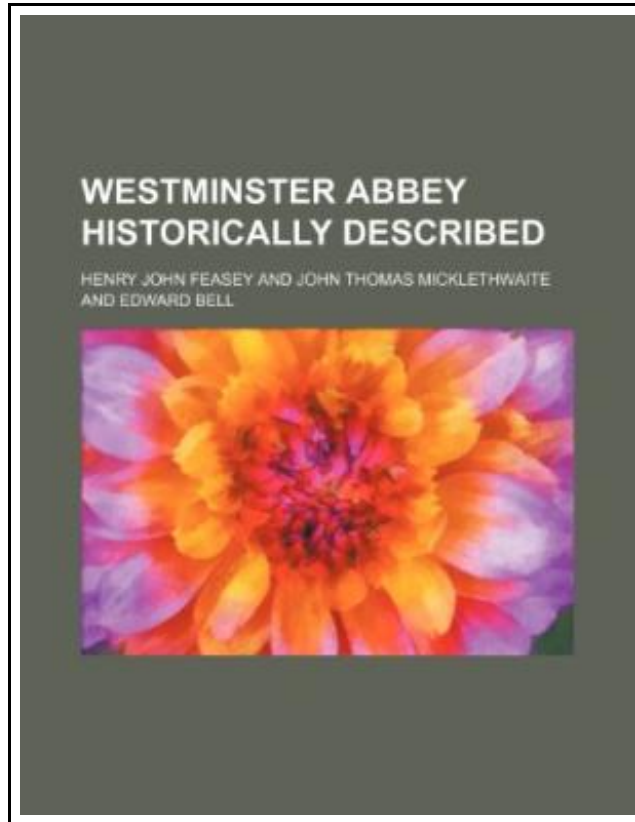

He was buried in the parish churchyard of Wisbeach, without the ancient rites or any memorial stone. Of the after-life of his companion-monks there is little to record. Of two only is there any definite information forthcoming. Austin Ringwode, we are told, having the fear of God before his eyes, though turned out of his old home (Glastonbury), dwelt in a cottage at no great distance from it, where through many long years he constantly observed his old rule, without relaxation. Towards the close of his life it is recorded that he was solaced with visions...
